The Rotary Youth Leadership Award programme is an international Rotary activity providing leadership and life skill development for young people. While the aims are the same, the programme differs in format and content from country to country and locality to locality.

Rotary International District 9940 covering the southern half of the North Island of New Zealand and consisting of some 60 plus Rotary Clubs run an annual residential programme over 5 days for young community and business leaders aged 18 to 24. 40 to 50 young men and women participate in a high level, intense programme of speakers, workshops, outdoor activities and the like from 6.30am to 10pm each day.

Since 2005 Yoshimi and Jon Brett, of TetraMap, have attended the RYLA programme on the first evening and following morning running at least two high impact sessions. Their Tetra Map programme exploring the personality types of people and the way they interact has provided an excellent foundation to the content of the RYLA which follows. It is fun, informative, well presented and well received.

Participants during the last 6 years have regularly described the sessions facilitated by Yoshimi with the music by Jon as one of the highlights of RYLA and consistently give them a very high rating in our programme assessment. We would struggle to replace Yoshimi and Jon with a meaningful similar input into our programme.

Accordingly the RYLA organising committee strongly recommend to any organisation, group company or government agency, Yoshimi and Jon Brett and their TetraMap. It is an amazing programme to which they should provide their members or staff, the opportunity to discover and experience.
